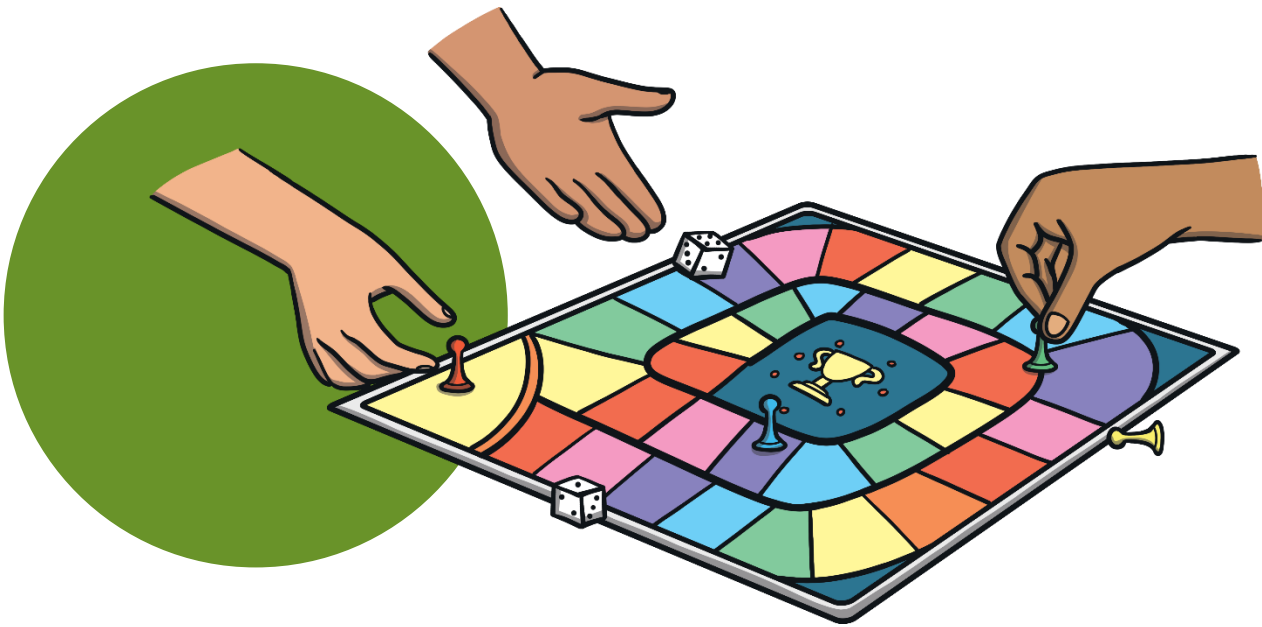

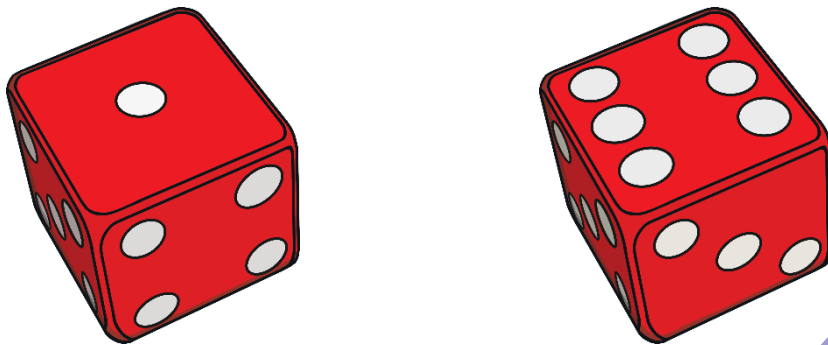
In my class, we sometimes play games in small groups.
